The mighty Chasetown team rise like a Phoenix

Friday the 7th October was the day in which Chasetown's young football team rose like a Phoenix from the flames to play their first football game in nearly 3 years.

The team consisted of a range of players from years 5, 6, 7 and 8 as the interest from the previous Friday training session was very encouraging. The players were very excited about the game that took place on home soil at 11am.



LHS brought a very strong squad that had played in football leagues over several years, and this was evident in the way in which LHS stormed into a 4-0 lead. Chasetown created some half chances in the first half when they finally stopped playing the occasion and focused on the job in hand.

Half time came at the wrong time for Chasetown as the team started to push LHS back into their own half, but they defend well.
