Football Festival



Chasetown Community school attended a football festival on Wednesday 22nd November 2023 at Burntwood leisure centre.

The festival began with a little bit of bad news for the organisers as a school cancelled at the last minute. However the pupils of Chasetown did not let this dampen their spirits. A number of pupils volunteered to work with the other schools that attended to enable equality and opportunities for all.

The first hour of the festival was led by a football coach who taught the pupils some new shooting drills as well as fun warm up games. These games helped the pupils to work together, build resilience whilst raising individuals self-esteem.



The second hour, there was a focus on match play. Chasetown were able to field two teams which meant that the other attending schools were able to play 4 games within the festival.

Chasetown were clearly operating at a different level than the two other schools, which saw both teams take very early comfortable leads against Rocklands and Two Rivers.

Event though the pupils wanted to win, something beautiful happened. The players of Chasetown started to encourage their opposition and helped them to score a number of goals past them. As a sportsman myself, I was truly blown away by the sportsmanship that the pupils displayed as they knew that they could have beaten both teams comfortably. However, instead of this the pupils helped others with less ability and gave them a memory and feeling that they may never forget.

Today the pupils at Chasetown enabled everyone to become a winner. The empathy and consideration of others was truly mind-blowing. To have members of the other schools staff come up and talk to the pupils and myself, mentioning what kind hearted and beautiful pupils that we have was a moment of proudness that I will not forget.
